PRODUCT COMPOSITION (Per gm)

- Vitamin B12: 0.05 mg
- Carrier- Dextrose: QS

DOSAGE

Poultry: Administer 1 g per 1-2 liters of drinking water.

Cattle: Mix 10-25 g per animal with the daily feed.

Or as directed by the Veterinarian.

STORAGE CONDITIONS

Store in a cool and dry place, protected from heat and light, away from reach of children.

SHELF LIFE

Minimum 2 years from the date of manufacturing, when stored as per the directions.

Side Effects (If Any)

Generally safe in livestock. Overdosage may cause:

- Mild to moderate loose droppings or diarrhea due to temporary digestive disturbance.
- Reduced feed or water intake caused by metabolic imbalance from excessive supplementation.
- Temporary restlessness or stress-related behavior, especially in poultry.
- Short-term digestive imbalance that may interfere with normal nutrient absorption.
- Transient reduction in growth or production performance until dosage is corrected.
